



REQUIREMENT FOR GOOD MINISTERIAL STANDING IN THE FL CONFERENCE UCC

As an Authorized Minister in the Florida Conference, you are part of a covenantal ministry we share with one another and with the wider United Church of Christ. Maintaining good standing is one way we honor this shared trust and support the health and vitality of your ministry.

The Florida Conference is committed to fostering excellence in ministry. Our Authorized Ministers and our congregations are invited to participate in a variety of events planned to cultivate ministerial, spiritual and congregational growth and development.

In order to maintain good standing in our Conference:

1. To remain in ministerial good standing, you must attend a boundary training (4 or more hours) every third year. We request that you email your certificate of attendance to registrar@uccfla.org so we can keep accurate records.
2. It is required that you complete an information review annually. The form can be found [here](#).
3. We encourage and expect our authorized ministers to engage in Lifelong Learning Continuing Education. If you participate in an educational event, please remember to email your certificate of attendance to registrar@uccfla.org.
